

## **Liberals press for more information on cancelled contracts**

The Liberals continue to ask for more information on the Hebron Benefits Agreement.

The Opposition is worried the province will lose out on work on the offshore project now that parts of it have been altered.

But Natural Resources Minister Kathy Dunderdale told the House of Assembly Wednesday the value of the cancelled contracts is "substantially less than \$50 million," or less than half-a-per cent of the total value of the Hebron project.

The government has repeatedly said if an equal value of work can't be found for local companies to do, the oil companies partnering on the project must cut the province a cheque, which will then be used towards other offshore projects.
