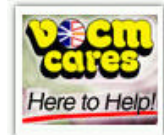

Opposition Raising Concerns About Lower Churchill Project

April 2, 2009

Opposition Leader Yvonne Jones is raising concerns as to how the province hopes to pay for the proposed Lower Churchill Project and the planned transmission line along the maritime route. Jones feels the project has not been properly costed. In the House of Assembly, Jones asked Natural Resources Minister Kathy Dunderdale to table the proposed capital costs of the project. The Minister says that information would compromise the contract process and the hopes of 'getting the best bang for their buck'. New Brunswick Premier Shawn Graham has 'put the province on notice' he would be looking for concessions from Newfoundland and Labrador to allow the power to be transmitted through its borders. Jones says government has not even consulted with those involved.
