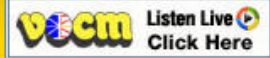

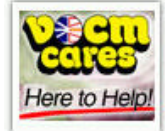

Workers in Limbo: Yvonne Jones April 7, 2009

Opposition Leader Yvonne Jones says almost two dozen workers in Grand Falls-Windsor are in limbo, the result of what she calls the 'bungling' of the expropriation of resources from [AbitibiBowater](#). Jones says expropriation under contract law may have left the Abitibi contract with workers of the generation plant void. Jones says she wasn't satisfied with the answers she received from Innovation Trade and Rural Development Minister Shawn Skinner in the House of Assembly. She says it seems government has failed to negotiate protection clauses under expropriation to secure the severance and holiday pay of workers. Jones says of the 22 power generation workers whose jobs were expropriated along with the facilities, only 17 are currently employed with NALCOR; 5 have been let go despite government assurances of job security.
