## Opposition Calls for Action on Smelly Situation



The Opposition Critic for Environment and Conservation says environmental concerns associated with the operation of the mink farm outside Heart's Delight -Islington are valid. Roland Butler believes mink farming is an important industry for rural Newfoundland and Labrador, but says proper disposal of farm waste is critical to protect the health of both people and animals. He says nearby landfills cannot accept the offal because of the volumes involved. Butler says government should look to helping the farm owner as well as enforcing waste disposal regulations. Residents are complaining about the odor, blaming it on the mink farm.
