Jones Wants Chartered Medical Flights



Opposition Leader Yvonne Jones wants the provincial government to address Air Labrador's decision to cease air service to southern Labrador. The MHA for Cartwright L'anse Au Clair says a chartered medical service that will fly patients to the necessary health care facilities must be in place, much like the system already used on the North Coast of Labrador. She says government must also move ahead with the construction of a regional airport at Port Hope Simpson to ensure that isolated communities without road infrastructure will have access to affordable and reliable transportation.
