## Medical Cuts Come Under Scrutiny



The Liberal Opposition continued to fire away at government for their decision to move lab and xray services out of Lewisporte and Flowers Cove.

Health Minister Paul Oram remains firm on the decision to move services out of the central and Northern Peninsula communities in favor of a more regional approach, but Opposition Leader Yvonne Jones says she's not backing down. The Opposition has filed a motion in the House to have the decision on lab and xray services reversed. It will remain on the order papers until it is debated, but officials say it could reappear in the fall session as a Liberal private member's motion.
