Petition Presented to Opposition



Opposition Leader Yvonne Jones says it's been over a decade since there was a study to examine the options to reduce moose-vehicle accidents, and she will ask the House of Assembly to examine the issue again. The Save Our People Action Committee has presented the opposition with a 20-thousand name petition. Jones says with more than 700 accidents annually on the highways, government needs to act. Eugene Nippard wants brush cut along the province's highways and more animals removed from the wild. He says as a last resort, a fence should be discussed.
