

Liberals ask province to help Marystown Shipyard

the House of Assembly Monday, Liberal MHA Kelvin Parsons asked Business Minister Ross Wiseman if the province would help the Marystown Shipyard with funding for a graving dock.

Parsons noted Ottawa announced a \$35-billion shipbuilding strategy last week and the shipyard has been asking for funding for the dock since 2006.

He said if the shipyard had the graving dock it would have a better chance getting lucrative federal contracts.

While Wiseman praised the work being done at the Marystown Shipyard, he said discussions on what funding the company needs are ongoing.
