Liberal Leader Calls on More Government Action to Protect Caribou Herd



Liberal Leader Yvonne Jones is calling on Government to do more to protect the Red Wine caribou herd. 150 Quebec Innu have moved into a closed hunting area of Labrador, indicating they're hunting for food, but also as a form of protest for their lack of involvement in land claim talks involving the Lower Churchill. Jones suggests the provincial government could do more to protect the animals. She suggests it's time to put collars on the remaining animals. Justice Minister Felix Collins says they're willing to meet with the Quebec Innu on the matter. He says the Innu have declined. He says at the end of the day, if you wipe out the caribou, it's wiping out the Innu culture and their way of life, so they'd be the big losers.
