## Accusations Fly Over Ferries



The Liberals are accusing government of spending a lot less than they say they've been spending on ferry replacement. Problems with the water transportation system have been large this past few years, but even more so this week when Bell Island found itself without a single ferry. The Flanders is back on the Tickle, but Transportation Minister Tom Hedderson says the Nonia will have to go on drydock for repairs as divers have not been able to remove all of the rope that got tangled in the vessel's bow thruster.

In the legislature yesterday, critic Roland Butler said Government has only spent \$10 million of a total \$49 million allocated for ferry replacement the past two years.
