## No Special Measures to Help Relocated Air Ambulance Employees



There will be no special measures to help employees of the air ambulance service who moved to Labrador from St. Anthony. Government left the Northern Peninsula in favour of Happy Valley-Goose Bay, forcing employees to make a decision. The MHA for the Straits-White Bay North, Marshall Dean, says housing costs are at a premium in Labrador, and that government should buy the employees' houses in St. Anthony at appraised value. He would also like to see a 12-month financial assistance plan instead of the current three months. Health Minister Jerome Kennedy says the current Treasury Board policy will apply to everybody.
