## Liberal MHA Seeks Government Funding for Seniors Resource Centre



The MHA for Port de Grave says the provincial government should consider addressing the funding shortfalls of the Seniors Resource Centre. Roland Butler says the centre has been forced to cut two full-time and two part-time positions, and government should consider addressing the gaps before programs have to be cut. Butler says the biggest shortfall comes from the federal government as a result of what appears to be a change in culture within the federal system in providing grants to groups like the Centre. He says while the provincial government is not responsible for the funding cuts, they have a role to play in protecting seniors and their programs.
