



# Opposition calls for details of funding approvals raised in Auditor General's report **LATEST NEWS**

Kelvin Parsons is calling on the provincial government to provide the names of three companies identified by the Auditor General as improperly receiving direct investments of more than \$1 million in public money and to provide details on how this funding was approved.

Parsons, the opposition industry critic and MHA for the District of Burgeo-Lapointe, noted the Auditor General's report concluded that the Department of Industry, Trade and Development did not act in compliance with the Financial Administration Act when providing funding to three companies.

Concerns were also raised that there was no documented procedures for approving, disbursing and monitoring such investments, he said.
