

## **Liberals raise more air-quality concerns**

Leader Yvonne Jones had more questions about air quality in schools for Education Minister Joan Burke in the House of Assembly Wednesday.

During the spring sitting of the House, the Liberals brought up the issue several times.

But in this case the school in question was the Seal Cove campus of the College of the North Atlantic.

Jones told the House that the campus was closed Wednesday morning after teachers and students became sick from fumes.

Burke could not confirm the cause of the air-quality problem, but did say officials from her department were looking into the matter.

Jones said the Opposition has had complaints about the air quality at the campus for a number of months.

Burke said she was unaware of previous problems at the school, but that if there are concerns they should be forwarded to her office and not be used to score political points in the House.
