Government Accused of Hypocrisy Over Sprinkler Issue

Opposition Leader Yvonne Jones is accusing government of being hypocritical when it comes to the issue of installing sprinkler systems in personal care homes. Jones says 22 of the homes will be shut down if systems are not installed, but government run health care facilities are in violation of the same policy. She says the Waterford Hospital, the Paddon Home in Happy Valley-Goose Bay, Curtis Hospital in St. Anthony, Western Memorial Regional Hospital in Corner Brook and clinics in coastal Labrador are also not in compliance with fire regulations.
