## Botched Test Results Raise Questions in House March 20, 2008

The latest information on the erroneous hormone receptor test results stirred some questioning in the legislature. This week Health Minister Ross Wiseman confirmed that of the 383 people whose results changed when retested, 108 have passed away. He pointed out a changed test result doesn't necessarily mean that appropriate cancer treatment was delayed. NDP Leader Lorraine Michael accused the minister of giving half answers with respect to the cause of death and down-playing the numbers. Wiseman in turn accused Michael of playing politics with a sensitive issue. Wiseman says since taking over the department he has been nothing but open and accountable. Liberal Leader Yvonne Jones says it is apparent government is providing important information, but only to a point where their own interests can be protected.
