Opposition Raises Conflict Of Interest Concerns April 9, 2008

The opposition is voicing concerns about conflict of interest after word a top civil servant and former Deputy Minister of Health has been subpoenaed to testify before the Cameron Inquiry. Liberal Leader Yvonne Jones says, while not questioning the integrity of Robert Thompson, she wonders whether his former positions as Deputy Minister and Clerk of the Executive Council doesn't conflict with his current role as government liaison with the [Cameron Inquiry](#). She questioned the Premier in the House of Assembly.
