Documents Nearly Destroyed May 6, 2008

The Opposition House Leader says government has to establish better protocols for deciding what historical documents should be destroyed. Kelvin Parsons says in the case of a number of documents sent from the Rooms to a local shredding company, archivists from Memorial University have estimated the documents are potentially worth between 120 and 150 thousand dollars. Parsons says those documents are currently involved in court case and have thankfully not been destroyed. He questioned Tourism Culture and Recreation Minister Clyde Jackman in the House of Assembly. Parsons says before any historical documents are destroyed, government should consult with outside agencies who may have an interest in preserving the information.
