Opposition Calls for Removal of Health Minister September 4, 2008

Opposition Leader Yvonne Jones says if there is any hope in restoring confidence to our health care system, the Premier must remove Health Minister Ross Wiseman from that portfolio immediately. She was commenting after testimony at the Cameron Inquiry from Cancer Society Executive Director Peter Dawe, that Wiseman and other senior government officials suggested he not be as outspoken in his criticism during the early days of the hormone receptor testing controversy. Dawe told the inquiry he didn't feel any pressure from Wiseman, who was then a parliamentary secretary, but that there were subsequent meetings with the deputy minister of health and then health minister, John Ottenheimer. Jones says it is totally inappropriate for elected officials to apply pressure on individuals and interest groups in an effort to avoid public criticism. She says it amounts to nothing more than intimidation and is unbecoming of a minister of the crown.
